



**Declaration of Intent on Non-Acceptance of Gifts and Rewards
for the Performance of Duties (No Gift Policy)
Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)**

The Office of the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation is committed to performing administrative duties adherence to the principles of good governance, focusing on operating with honesty, integrity, transparency, accountability, and bringing the utmost benefits to the public, in compliance to the National Reform Plan for the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised version) Activity 4: Develop the Thai bureaucratic system to be transparent and nonbeneficial.

Therefore, the Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation declares itself to be **“an organization where all state officials do not accept gifts or rewards of any kind for the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy)”**. Executives and officials must abstain from accepting any gifts or rewards, whether prior to, during, or following their duties, for all occasions. This rule is aimed at eliminating or reducing the chance of receiving inappropriate influence. Such restrictions are necessary to ensure unbiased decision-making and to prevent unethical practices or conduct, both currently and in the future. Furthermore, every executive and supervisor across all levels is expected to exemplify adherence to applicable laws and regulations. Additionally, they are responsible for ensuring that officials under their supervision act in a manner that is both appropriate and responsible.
